"Camino de Santiago" is an exhibition of 60 photos taken by Philippe Cadelon on his way to "Santiago de Compostella" in Spain, between Saint-Jean-Pied-de-Port, in the South West of France and the Galician apostle town...

Surrounded by the photos, Philippe Cadelon tells the story of his pilgrimage, taking the "Camino" as a cultural, spiritual and philosophical symbol of a universal quest... He illustrates his comments with a selection of French, Spanish, and German songs, thus inviting the audience to join him on his inner journey...

As an actor and singer Philippe Cadelon has performed in several musicals in Paris, such as "Les Années Twist" in the Folies Bergère (Winner of the Molière Award for best musical), "La vie Parisienne" and "Roméo et Juliette"... He recorded an album with the American singer Barbara Scaff and directed his first musical "Mon homme" in 2005... He is also a photographer and exposes his pictures since 2002, always narrating his images through songs...
